# The Club

## Getting there is the first part

You can reach the Rugbyclub Leuven grounds only through the main entrance at **Koetsweg 204A, 3010 Leuven / Kessel-Lo.**



You can use either parking 1 or 2.

Please note there is no passage from parking 2 to pitch 2.



You can park your bike at the bike storage located in front of the clubhouse.

Remember to lock your bike at all times.



From Leuven Station, take bus line #3 Leuven - Pellenberg - Lubbeek.

The ride will take about 20 minutes.

# The Clubhouse

Dehydration must be avoided at all cost

- The clubhouse opens...
  - ... on training days **30 minutes** before the training session starts
  - ... on match days **90 minutes** before kick off time
- The clubhouse has a strict **no cash** policy. Members can use their clubcard, all other visitors can pay by Bancontact, Maestro, Payconiq or mobile. We do not accept creditcards.
- For the benefit of all visitors, studded footwear is not allowed in the clubhouse.

# The Dressing Room

## Gearing up for battle

- There are 4 player dressing rooms and 2 referee dressing rooms available.
- Club members use their dedicated dressing room on *training days*.
- On *match days*, it will be indicated on the door which team the dressing room is reserved for.
- **After the final whistle, please make sure your dressing room is vacated swiftly, so we have time left to sanitise everything for the next team.**

# The Pitch

Where we settle our differences.

- Rugbyclub Leuven has a grass and an artificial pitch. It will be indicated upfront what pitch you play on.
  - **Grass pitch:** studded footwear or blades. **NO** mullet studs.
  - **Artificial pitch:** *plastic conical* studded footwear only. **NO** metal, **NO** blades, **NO** mullets, **NO** flat soles.

• **ONLY THE ARTIFICIAL PITCH WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR SEASON 2020-2021**

- Footwear needs to be clean, in good condition, and comply with World Rugby Regulation 12 (*studded, max 21mm, rounded, no sharp edges*).
- Players not using the appropriate footwear will not be allowed on pitch.



# The Covid19 extras

We play it safe.

- **Club members** are obliged to register themselves for all training sessions and fixtures through Twizzit.
- **Players and all staff** of visiting teams can only enter the pitch enclosure when duly registered on the game sheet in Twizzit.
- **Every visitor** not on a game sheet **must register** before entering the club grounds through our **contact tracing QR** at the main entrance.
- **Everyone** (players, staff, fans, ...) wears a mask at the club grounds unless seated, and should respect the 1.5 meter social distancing. *If needed, masks are available at the clubhouse (5€).*
